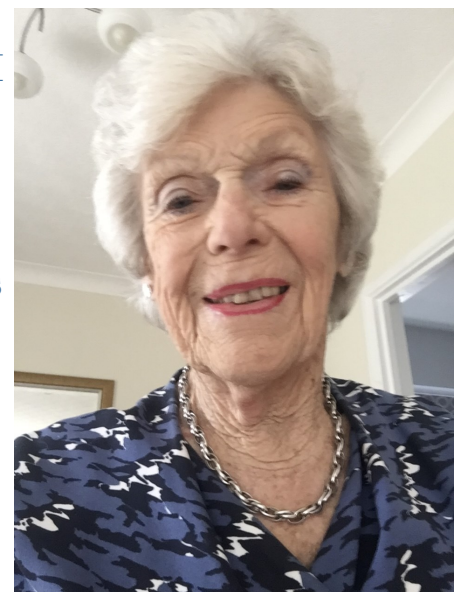


My Name is Sara Grier. I was Vice President of the Club when it was formed in 1977. Since then I have been President 1978—1979 and

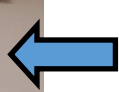

Having been Club Correspondent, International Service officer, Vice President and currently Treasurer I have witnessed what a difference we can make in other people's lives.



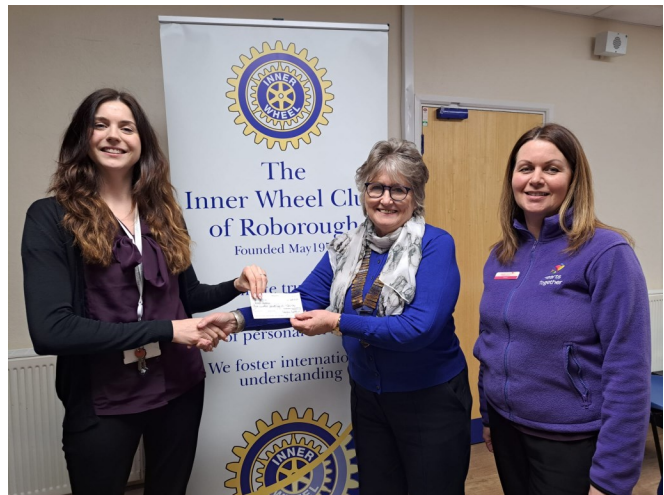
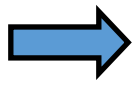
My goodness we are so very lucky to have you all and what an example you do set for the rest of us. Feel very proud of you.

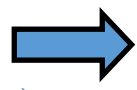
